The Relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis

Will visit Newry Cathedral today, Sunday 17th September. The relic will arrive at 12 noon and will leave after the 5.30pm Mass. Archbishop Domenico Sorrentino, Monsignor Anthony Figueiredo and Sister Alessandra Rusca will celebrate the Mass at 12 noon. After the 12 noon Mass Monsignor Figueiredo will give a talk on Blessed Carlo Acutis. Archbishop Eamon Martin will celebrate the 5.30pm Mass. Carlo died on 12th October 2006, aged 15. He was buried in the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi, Assisi, Italy. He was beatified on the 10^{th of} October 2020, two days before the 14th Anniversary of his death.
